COVID-19 Daily Briefing

December 30, 2020

Updated weekdays by approximately 12:30pm

Two hundred and ninety-seven new cases have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 20,374 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All daily cases reported by the State are presumed Forsyth County residents but may later transfer to another county if the case is later identified as not residing in Forsyth County. Of the 20,374, 17,353 are presumed recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.
